

Children, Youth & Families Worker

Job Description

Location: Mansfield Baptist Church

Vision/Purpose of Role: To develop MBC Children and Families ministry in sympathy with the vision, values and mission of the church "to see people's lives transformed in the love and power of Jesus." To build on and develop the existing children, youth and families work and mission at MBC.

Salary: £16.38 per hour

Hours of work: 12 hours per week, for 40 weeks per annum (term-time working). These hours will focus on our core children, youth and families ministry within the church particularly on Sundays, but also on building connections with children, youth and families, both within the church and in the wider community, so children, youth and families can together discover and grow in their relationship and walk with Jesus.

Contract Status: Permanent

Additional hours: 10.5 hours per week, for 40 weeks per annum (term-time working) for a period of 3 years. These additional hours will focus on supporting the church's aim over the next 3 years to increase its conversion growth (new believers) through equipping people and increasing evangelism and outreach through personal witness and/or events that make Jesus known.

Key Responsibilities:

1. Leading the Children's team and together inspiring, teaching, and nurturing the children's faith through worship, teaching and prayer delivered in a Spirit filled and engaging way. It is expectant the worker would join the Church family at MBC.

This would involve:

- Preparation and Delivery of 1 Sunday teaching per month (6 Hours)
- Be available for supporting the team for 2 Sundays per month and liaise and connect with Families who attend the church after the morning service. This may occasionally mean providing cover for

sickness of volunteers (3hours each session)

- Be able to pastorally support families as the need arises through messages and visits if needed.
- Planning the termly Themes and Rota (every 3 months)
- Planning and preparation of activities packs for holiday times.
- Planning and delivery of the Christmas All age service
- Administration
- Meetings: Termly whole team meeting including the Pastor (3 times per year). Line management review. Weekly A prayer and support meeting with church staff 1 hour per week
- Attend a training event/conference for resourcing and growing skills and a personal retreat for personal growth 1 per year each

Additional 10.5 hours (for 3 years)

- Support the existing ministries and build relationships with the Toddler team and the youth group who connect with families and young people outside of Sundays to assist these groups in their mission.
- Organise outreach events and initiatives and together with the toddler and youth team groups, develop new and creative pathways for growing new disciples (training and support will be given to help with this).

Overtime: Extra Duty hours to be claimed when content of job description exceeds contracted hours
